Educating and Developing Coaches in a High Performance Environment

Dr. Laurie Patterson, Prof. Susan Backhouse and Sergio Lara-Bercial are researchers based at Leeds Beckett University in the UK, currently working in collaboration with the International Council for Coaching Excellence (ICCE) on a project funded by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

They asked for the ASPC contribution to develop the project: Educating and Developing Coaches in a High Performance Environment.

The aim of the project is to provide guidance for an international anti-doping training program for high performance coaches and has been reviewed and approved by the ASPC Research Committee, which decided that this research project seemed to be interesting for ASPC and for ASPC members because anti-doping is an extremely important topic for every high performance centers. Of course it is your own decision to participate.

You should have received an information sheet about this research from Silvia back in November 2015 – if you don't have the information, please let Silvia know or you can contact the research team via Dr. Laurie Patterson at L.Patterson@leedsbeckett.ac.uk.
