#### LANDSCAPE REVIEW



Coaches are more likely to be familiar with and have used the Gateway than athletes

65% coaches predominantly want the Gateway to focus on sports related education, while athletes are more likely to prefer a broader range of academic options (57%)

The majority of coaches (63%) reported viewing continuing education as a means to strengthen their careers




