

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

WADA – WORLD ANTI-DOPING AGENCY

AND

INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF HIGH PERFORMANCE SPORT TRAINING CENTERS

The WORLD ANTI-DOPING AGENCY, WADA and the INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF HIGH PERFORMANCE SPORT TRAINING CENTERS, IAHPSTC (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"),

RECOGNISING the importance of sustaining and developing sports.

DESIRING to strengthen the existing friendly relations and co-operation between both Parties

HAVE REACHED THE FOLLOWING UNDERSTANDING:

Paragraph 1

GENERAL OBJECTIVES

This Memorandum of Understanding provides the framework within which detailed proposals for educational programs for the sports groups in the centers, are to be jointly considered between the Parties on the basis of reciprocity and mutual benefit.

This Memorandum of Understanding is a statement of intention between the parties in relation to the issues mentioned in it. It is not intended that this Memorandum of Understanding create any contractual relationship or that it be legally binding on the parties.

Paragraph 2

FRAMEWORK

The Parties intend to encourage and facilitate, as appropriate, the education environment for all the involved people of the organization to share their knowledge and experience related to the development of an honest and healthy sport practice in their training sites.

Paragraph 3

FIELDS OF COOPERATION .

The primary objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to facilitate educational materials and sharing opportunities related to the anti-doping literature and media produced by WADA for the respective training groups of all the affiliated centers members of the IAHPSTC.

In order to pursue the above Framework and primary objective of cooperation, either Party may propose specific arrangements and / or additional fields of cooperation for mutual benefit to be considered by the other Party. Yearly activities or projects are described in the annex that will be attached to this memorandum.



Paragraph 4

FORMS OF COOPERATION

Cooperation under this Memorandum of Understanding is intended to include:

- a. Supplies of teaching and education materials on anti-doping contents, provided by WADA.
- c. Exchange of information on anti-doping contents, including information provided by coaches and athletes in order to improve the quality of the education materials.
- c. Supplies of experts from WADA to be arranged locally by WADA Delegates if necessary.
- d. Interaction through new technologies on teaching with the use of Internet and advanced interactive content management systems.

Paragraph 5

FUNDING

The present Memorandum of Understanding is intended to exclude any direct cost for the parties out of the standards already established by WADA in their global campaigns.

IAHPSTC will share the material with its Centers members as a bonus to help in their education programs regarding anti-doping.

Relations are entered into between the WADA and IAHPSTC to further promote the benefits of the relationship developed by this Memorandum of Understanding in the lead up to the 2012 Olympic Games in London.

Paragraph 6

IMPLEMENTATION

- a. The Parties intend to make arrangements for the implementation and development of specific educational programs provided by WADA under this Memorandum of Understanding through the most convenient channels and divulgation.
- b Such arrangements will cover the subjects of cooperation procedures, treatment of intellectual property and other appropriate matters;

Paragraph 7

AMENDMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual consent in writing between the Parties.

A handwritten signature in black ink, appearing to be 'H. S.', with a large flourish. Below the signature, the initials 'RBC' are written in a similar style.

Paragraph 8

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE

Any dispute between the Parties arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding is expected to be settled amicably by consultation or negotiation.

Paragraph 9

CONSULTATIONS

The Parties are expected to consult together upon request of either Party regarding any matter relating to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding.


Paragraph 10


